# Your Next Adventure is Waiting

There's more to scenic Southern Indiana than what meets the eye. Adventure lovers can canoe down Blue River located in the heart of cave country. Enjoy a quick rest or a picnic lunch along the public gravel bars and beach areas, and stay on the lookout for the abundant wildlife including turtles, eagles, otters, and more. Half day, full day, and even two-day trips are available for all skill levels and abilities.

Below the rolling hills, majestic forests, and winding Blue River lies a secretive network of caverns and caves just waiting to be explored. Guided tours take you deep into our greatest natural treasure where you can walk alongside underground streams, investigate captivating cave formations, discover fossils, and observe fascinating plant and animal life hundreds of feet below the earth's surface. Tours vary in length and terrain, but most are easy walks the whole family can enjoy. And with a constant temperature of 52 degrees, the caves are a perfect outing all year long.

After diving below the earth, it's time to fly high. Harness yourself for the zipline ride of your life at Squire Boone Caverns Zipline Adventures, zooming over caverns and treetops. From introductory trips designed to give newbies just a taste of zipline action to whizzing down Indiana's longest zipline, we have an exciting excursion for everyone. If you're a true adventure enthusiast, be sure to check out the Bat Chaser aerial coaster for the thrill of a lifetime. Riders summit a 50-foot tower before twisting and turning 603 feet to the ground with the option to free fall. This ride's a Corydon must-do!

## Indiana Caverns Family Adventure Park

Enjoy a guided, 90-minute tour including a 25-minute boat ride in an underground river. See evidence of animal life in the cave during the last Ice Age through bones and markings, especially in the Big Bone Mountain Room. Tour includes a majestic view of a 35-foot underground waterfall.

**The Bat Chaser Aerial Coaster:** a 50-foot tower to zipline and freefall on a one-of-a-kind track.

**Two Escape Rooms:** Save miners trapped underground or escape an ancient Egyptian temple—before it's too late!

**Deep Darkness:** A 4-hour cave exploration tour begins with a 93-foot climb down a ladder with belay, then continues with another descent down a slope to a subterranean river. The expedition continues upstream by foot, then by kayak, as the water deepens into a stream 200 feet below ground.

Discovered by two children in 1883 and later designated as a U.S. National Landmark, you can choose between two cavern tours for different experiences: The Crystal Palace Tour or the Dripstone Trail Tour.

**Pedal Karts:** Compete against the clock as you race pedal carts on a track winding through the woods! Appropriate for almost every age, with a separate track where little ones can give it a try.

**Miner's Mega Maze:** Participants are timed as they navigate an 8,000 square foot maze. See the maze from above at the lookout tower if you need some help!

**Cave Exploration:** Choose from five trips to rarely seen parts of the cave, and be warned—dress to get muddy and to have a great time.

**Indoor Miniature Golf:** Marengo Cave's newest attraction adds even more to do in any weather.

# Caves

A new entrance to the cave was opened in 2017, exposing formations that had been hidden for millennia. Soak in the splendor of the country's largest rimstone dam, now viewable from all angles, and the Rock of Ages, a formation 40 feet tall and estimated to be over a million years old.

**Squire Boone Village:** The caverns were discovered in 1790 by Squire Boone and his brother, the frontiersman Daniel Boone. Squire made a homestead on the property. He built a gristmill there in 1809, which has been restored to function again today, and is powered by a stream that flows from within the caverns. Gain insight into the pioneer experience through candle and soap making demonstrations in the Squire Boone Village, and don't miss Boone's Kitchen and Candy Shop for lunch or their renowned old-fashioned rock candy and homemade fudge! Open Memorial Day through Labor Day.

# Parks

## O'Bannon Woods State Park

Hike 18 miles of day-use trails in the gorgeous scenery of Southern Indiana. Practiced hikers can go for the 25.5-mile Adventure Trail, a three-day hike with five shelters for overnight stays along the way. The trails are also a popular destination for mountain biking and horseback riding. Grab your swimsuit for The Family Aquatic Center with exciting water features and slides for all ages. The Nature Center offers resources and cultural displays, live snakes and turtles, birdwatching, and living history demonstrations at a pioneer farmstead with a one-of-a-kind, restored 1850s hay press. Bring your own canoe to paddle the 11 miles of Blue River accessible from the park.

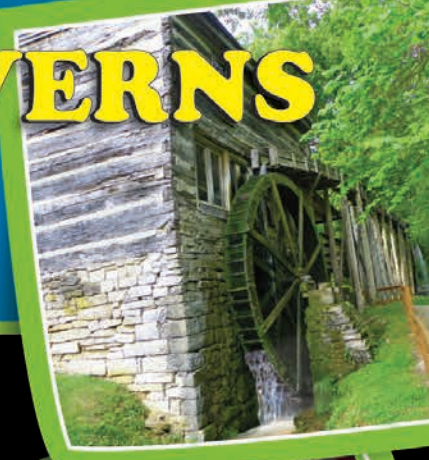

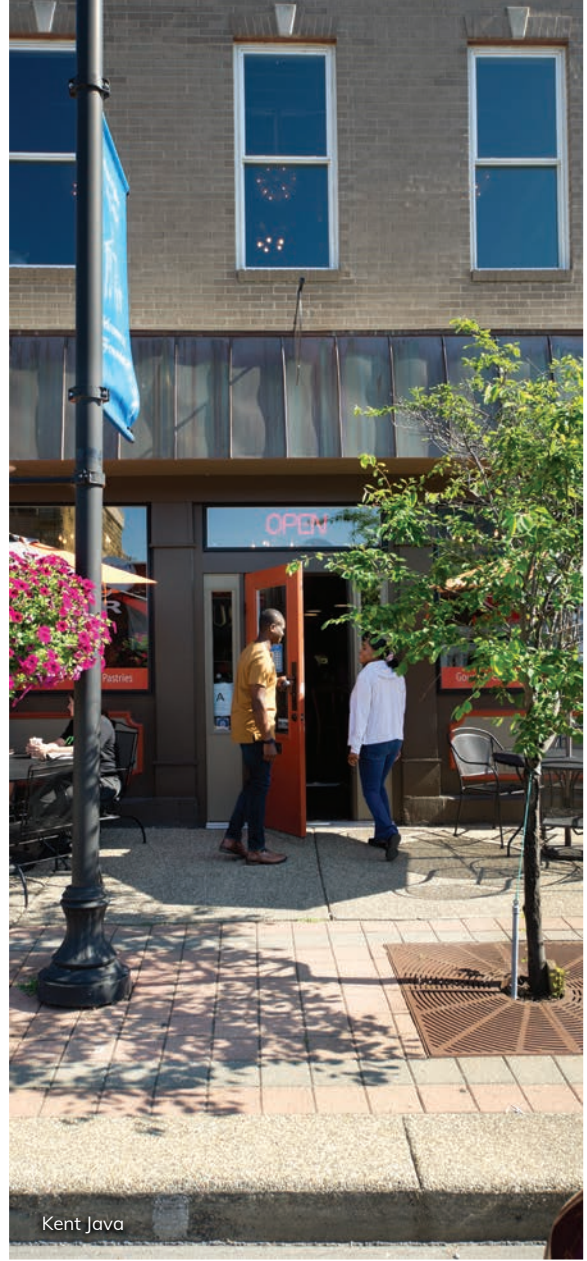

# Historic Downtown Corydon

The nostalgia is palpable as you walk the storied streets of Corydon. Established in 1808, the town served as Indiana's first state capital. Today, that same historic charm permeates the downtown where most buildings date back to the 1800s and showcase 19th-century Federal-style architecture and Indiana limestone construction.

Peek into the past by touring the beloved capitol building and governor's headquarters. Or immerse yourself in the area's longtime wildlife, natural science, and history with interactive displays at the Harrison County Discovery Center. Then settle in for a 360-degree projection portraying the only Civil War battle fought on Indiana soil, the Battle of Corydon.

Step back in time at Corydon Capital Day—a 19th-century-themed event buzzing with live entertainment, games, good eats, and interactive activities. Other historic events and attractions include seasonal haunted history tours, the Constitution Elm, Battle of Corydon Memorial Park, and a self-guided historic downtown Corydon walking tour.

History isn't the only thing that makes Corydon unique: The entire downtown is completely independently owned and operated. You'll find businesses that stand apart from anywhere else, such as Zimmerman Art Glass with daily glassblowing demonstrations and Butts Drugs, a family-owned soda fountain in operation since 1952.
