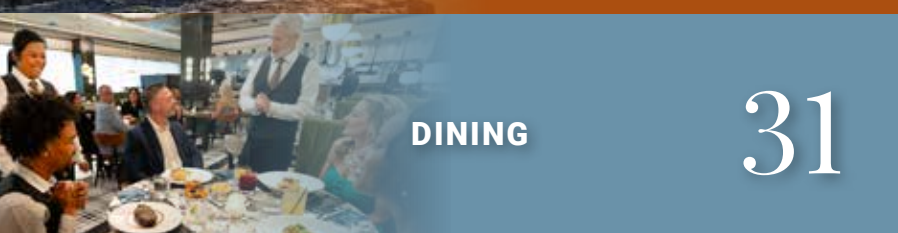

# CAVES

## Indiana Caverns Family Adventure Park

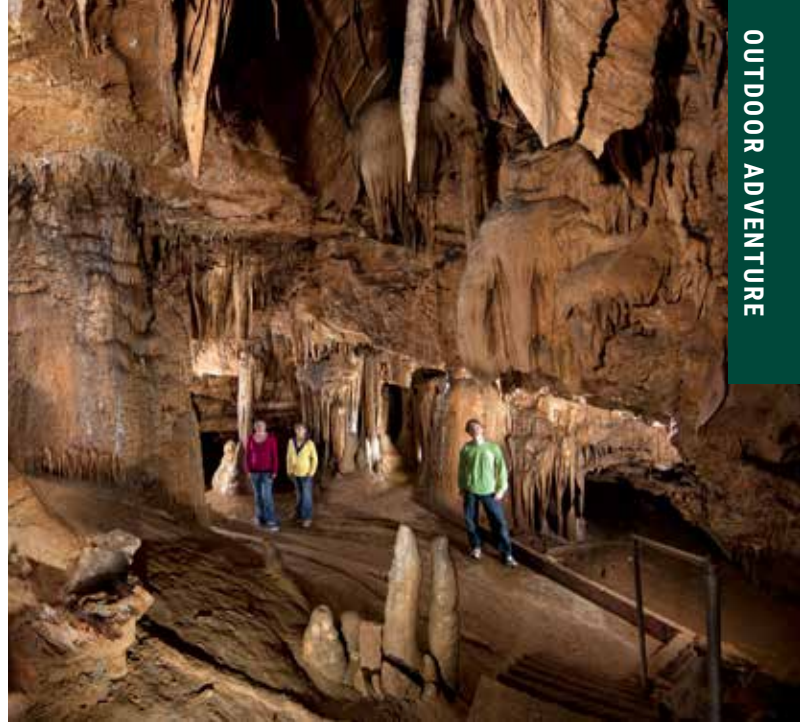

Enjoy a guided, 90-minute tour including a 25-minute boat ride in an underground river. See evidence of animal life in the cave during the last Ice Age through bones and markings, especially in the Big Bone Mountain Room. Tour includes a majestic view of a 35-foot underground waterfall.

**The Bat Chaser Aerial Coaster:** a 50-foot tower to zip-line and free fall on a one-of-a-kind track.

**Deep Darkness:** A 4-hour cave exploration tour begins with a 93-foot climb down a ladder with belay, then continues with another descent down a slope to a subterranean river. The expedition continues upstream by foot, then by kayak, as the water deepens into a stream 200 feet below ground.

**Indiana Caverns Pygmy Playground:** Come meet our pygmy goats at Indiana Caverns - Buck, Oreo, Bambi, Chip! You can meet and feed them! Your kids will love our "kids." Watch them on their own playground, where they can climb and explore among the trees of their enclosure.



## Marengo Cave

Discovered by two children in 1883 and later designated as a U.S. National Landmark, you can choose between two cavern tours for different experiences: The Crystal Palace Tour or the Dripstone Trail Tour.

**Pedal Karts:** Compete against the clock as you race pedal carts on a track winding through the woods! Appropriate for almost every age, with a separate track where little ones can give it a try.

**Miner's Mega Maze:** Participants are timed as they navigate an 8,000 square foot maze. See the maze from above at the lookout tower if you need some help!

**Cave Exploration:** Choose from five trips to rarely seen parts of the cave, and be warned—dress to get muddy and to have a great time.

**Indoor Miniature Golf:** Marengo Cave's newest attraction adds even more to do in any weather. Marengo Cave Skyclimber: Vertically 30 feet tall, 8 layers to climb up, enclosed with netting all around. Spiral slide back down, must be at least 42 inches. Fast exciting slide down!

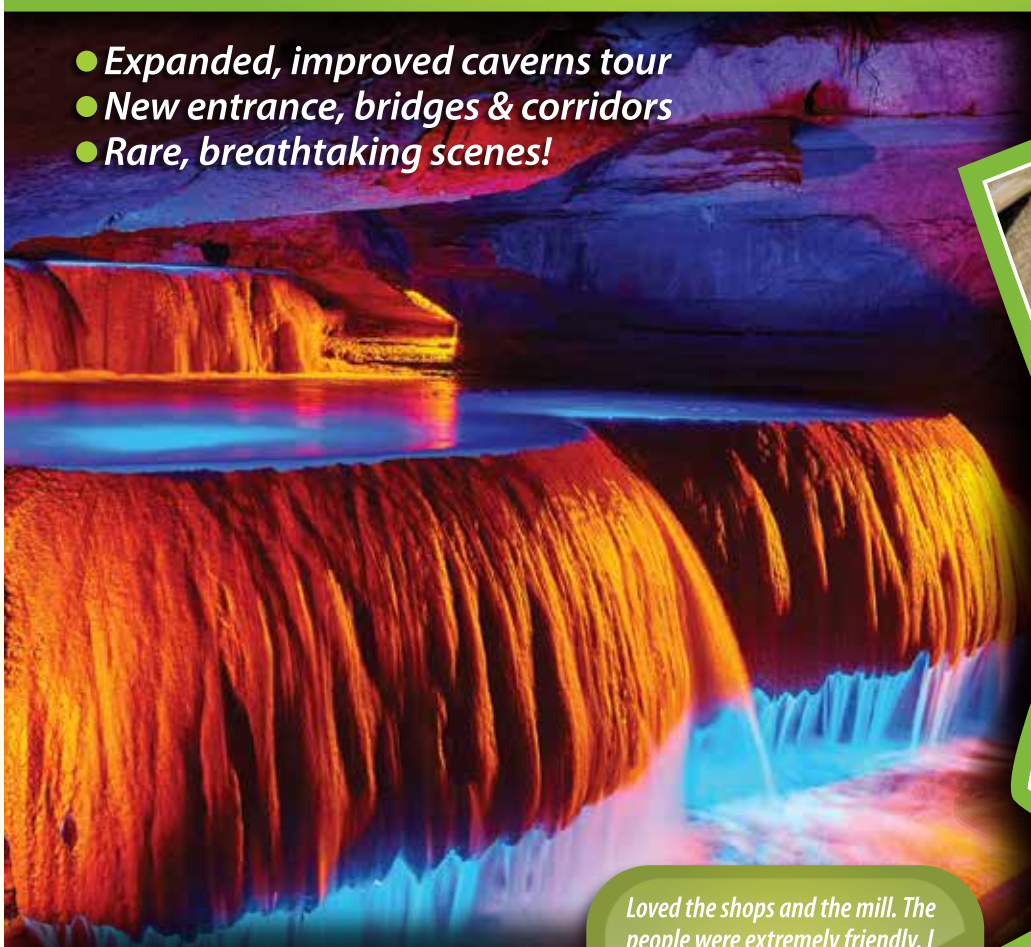

## Squire Boone Caverns & Village

A new entrance to the cave was opened in 2017, exposing formations that had been hidden for millennia. Soak in the splendor of the country's largest rimstone dam, now viewable from all angles, and the Rock of Ages, a formation 40 feet tall and estimated to be over a million years old.

**Squire Boone Village:** Gain insight into the pioneer experience through candle and soap making demonstrations in the Squire Boone Village. Don't miss Boone's Kitchen and Candy Shop for lunch or their renowned old-fashioned rock candy and homemade fudge. Open Memorial through Labor Day.

**Historic Boone's Mill:** Built by Squire Boone in the early 1800s, the restored mill still grinds grain just as it did two centuries ago. The 18-foot mill wheel, powered by water flowing from the caverns, turns the 1,000-pound grinding stones. Watch as the miller demonstrates how corn is ground into cornmeal and grits. Open Memorial through Labor Day.

**Squires Barnyard:** An homage to pioneer life with one big difference: Our animals were rescued and given a home with lots of love and care. Follow the walkway through the barnyard as you feed and interact with the goats & mini pigs! Open Memorial through Labor Day.

Wyandotte Caves have reopened to the public for guided walking tours! The caves are located within O'Bannon Woods State Park in the Harrison-Crawford State Forest. Designated in 1972 as a National Natural Landmark, Wyandotte Cave offers two walking tours Friday-Sunday Memorial through Labor Day weekend. The Little Wyandotte Tour is an easy 30-minute walking tour open to all ages. Admire the many flowstone and dripstone formations throughout this smaller cave. The Big Wyandotte Tour is a two-hour tour for ages 6 and over only. Explore "Monument Mountain" and deeper sections of Big Wyandotte Cave. View rare formations such as helictites, epsomite and prehistoric flint quarries.

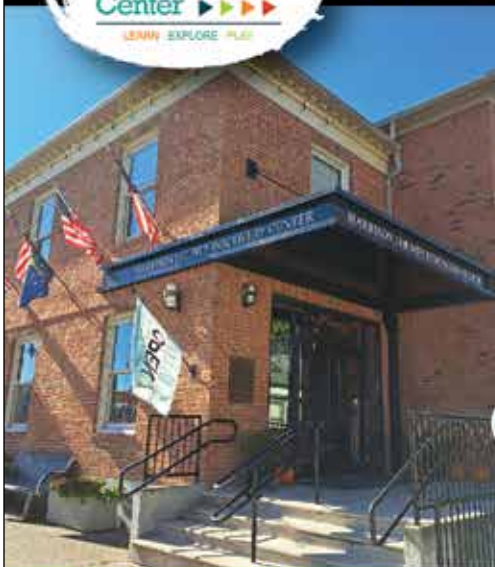

## O'Bannon Woods State Park

Hike, bike or horseback ride 18 miles of day-use trails or the 25.5-mile Adventure Trail, a three-day hike with five shelters for overnight stays along the way. Swim at the Family Aquatic Center with exciting water features for all ages. Paddle 11 miles of the Blue River, accessible from the park. Or visit the Nature Center, featuring cultural displays, live animals, and interpretive history demonstrations at a pioneer farmstead.

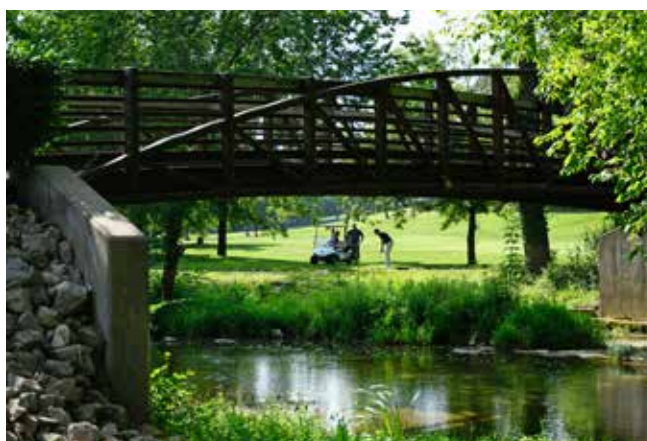

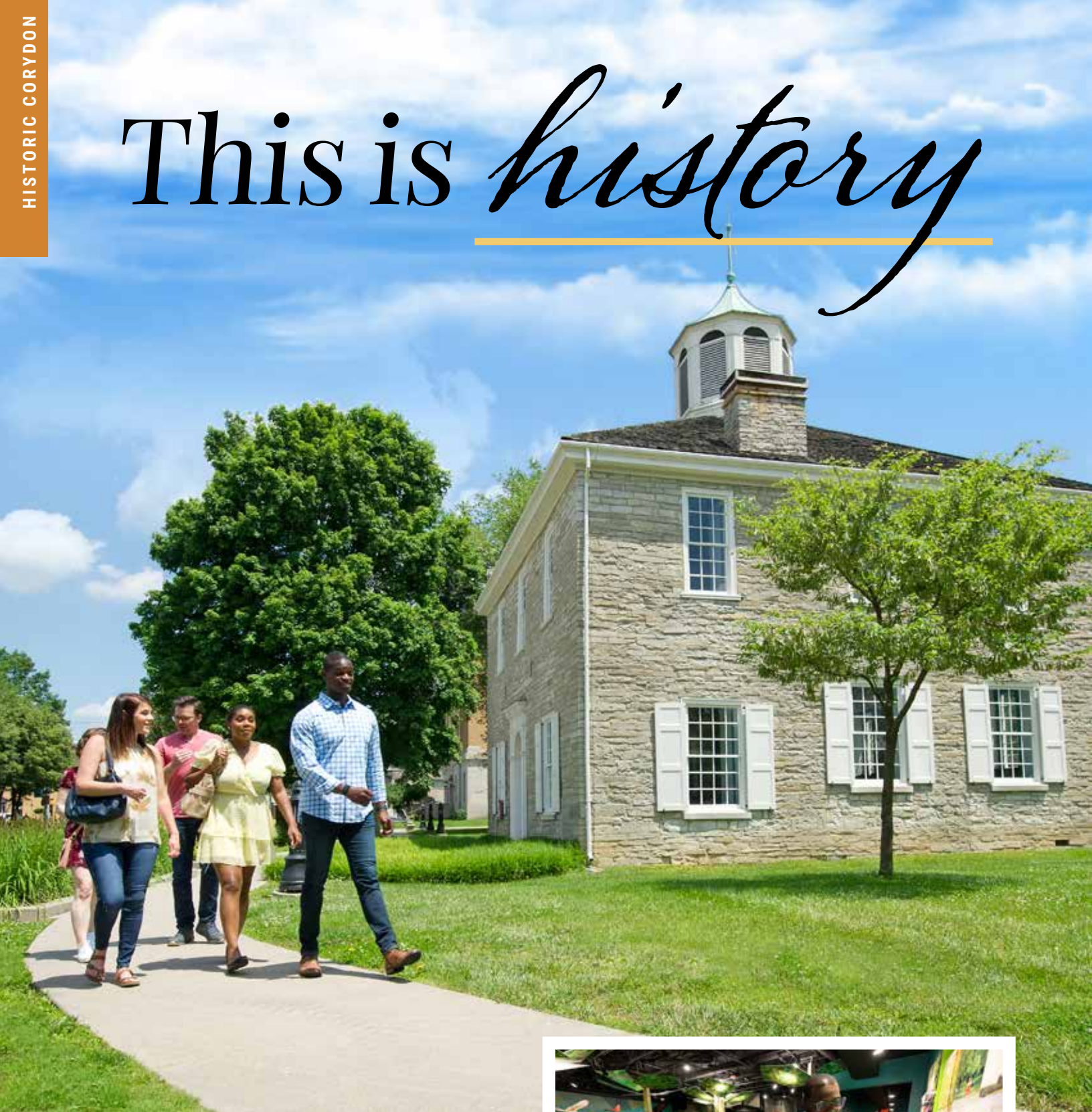

# HISTORIC DOWNTOWN CORYDON

As Indiana's first capital city, Corydon is not just a place on the map – it's a living storybook, brimming with tales from days gone by and welcoming folks eager to share them. Whether you're a history buff or just looking for a fun way to spend the day, Corydon's historic sites are sure to charm you.

Start your journey right where Indiana's story began – the original Capitol building in the heart of downtown. Wander through the 19th-century limestone statehouse and imagine the lively debates and decisions that shaped the early years of Indiana's statehood. Corydon's downtown historic district is filled with beautifully preserved Federal-style buildings, each with its own story to tell and friendly locals happy to point out their favorite spots.

Don't miss the chance to step inside the Harrison County Discovery Center, a true gem for curious minds of all ages. This interactive museum brings the history of the area to life with hands-on exhibits, fascinating artifacts, and engaging displays about Corydon's role in Indiana's past. Kids and grown-ups alike will love learning about everything from pioneer days when Indiana was just a territory to Civil War events and even the natural history and caves of the area.

As you stroll through town, you'll find plenty more to discover. Visit Governor Hendricks' Headquarters, peek into historic homes, and take a guided walking tour to learn about the famous Battle of Corydon—the only Civil War battle fought in Indiana. Each stop offers a warm welcome and a chance to step back in time, all while enjoying the small-town hospitality that makes Corydon so special.

After soaking up all that history, be sure to check out the local shops and eateries sprinkled throughout these storied streets. Grab a bite at a cozy café, browse for antiques, or chat with shopkeepers who are always happy to share a story or two. # HISTORIC SITES

 Located in Downtown Corydon

To tour the Corydon Capitol State Historic Site & Governor Hendricks Headquarters, tickets for a guided tour must be purchased online at [www.indianamuseum.org](http://www.indianamuseum.org) or in person at the State Historic Site.

## A Walking Tour of Historic Downtown Corydon

Learn about Corydon's two centuries of history by walking through its storied streets. Maps available at the Blaine H. Wiseman Visitor Center.

## Battle of Corydon Memorial Site

100 Old Hwy. 135 SW | Corydon | 812-738-8236

This park commemorates the only Civil War battle fought on Indiana soil. During the battle, 450 Home Guard bravely attempted to delay Morgan's 2,400 Confederate soldiers.

## Branham Tavern

419 N Capitol Ave. | Corydon

One of Corydon's original buildings, this two-story log cabin served as a local watering hole operated by William Branham from 1809 to 1819. Before that, it was the living quarters of Territorial Governor William Henry Harrison, who later became the ninth U.S. President.

## Corydon Capitol State Historic Site

Experience life when Corydon was Indiana's capital, from 1816 to 1825. Visit the Federal-style limestone capitol building and Governor Hendricks' Headquarters, a two-story brick home and office

## Constitution Elm

200 W. High St. | Corydon | 812-738-4890

In 1816, Indiana delegates met under this expansive elm to draft the first Indiana Constitution. Its branches have since been trimmed and the trunk preserved, which is encased in a large sandstone monument.

## Governor Hendricks' Headquarters

202 E Walnut St. | Corydon | 812-738-4890

Built in 1817, this two-story federal style brick house, became the headquarters and home of William Hendricks while he was governor of Indiana from 1822-1825. The house was later acquired by Judge William A. Porter in 1841.

## Harrison County Discovery Center

233 N. Capitol Ave. | Corydon | 812-734-0030

This museum brings Harrison County's past into the present. Explore history, nature, caves, the Civil War, and more through interactive and immersive high-tech displays.

## Leora Brown School

400 East Summit St. | Corydon | Not Open for Tours

A simple one-room wooden structure built in 1891 for the education of African American children; the school stands as a testament to the motivation of those children taught during the days of segregation. It is one of Indiana's oldest standing African American elementary/secondary schools.

## Porter Law Office

Walnut St | Corydon | 812-738-4890

The Porter Law Office was built in 1819 by Henry P. Coburn while he was serving as the Clerk of Indiana State Supreme Court. Coburn continued his service as Clerk, moving with the capitol to Indianapolis in 1825. The building was then rented and later purchased by William Porter, a probate judge, member and speaker of the Indiana House of Representatives and the State Senate. The building is open for tours as part of Corydon Capitol State Historic Site.

## Indiana's First State Office Building

Walnut St | Corydon | 812-738-4890

Built in 1817, this brick building was rented to the State of Indiana for offices while Corydon was the State Capitol. Not open for tours.





# This is excitement

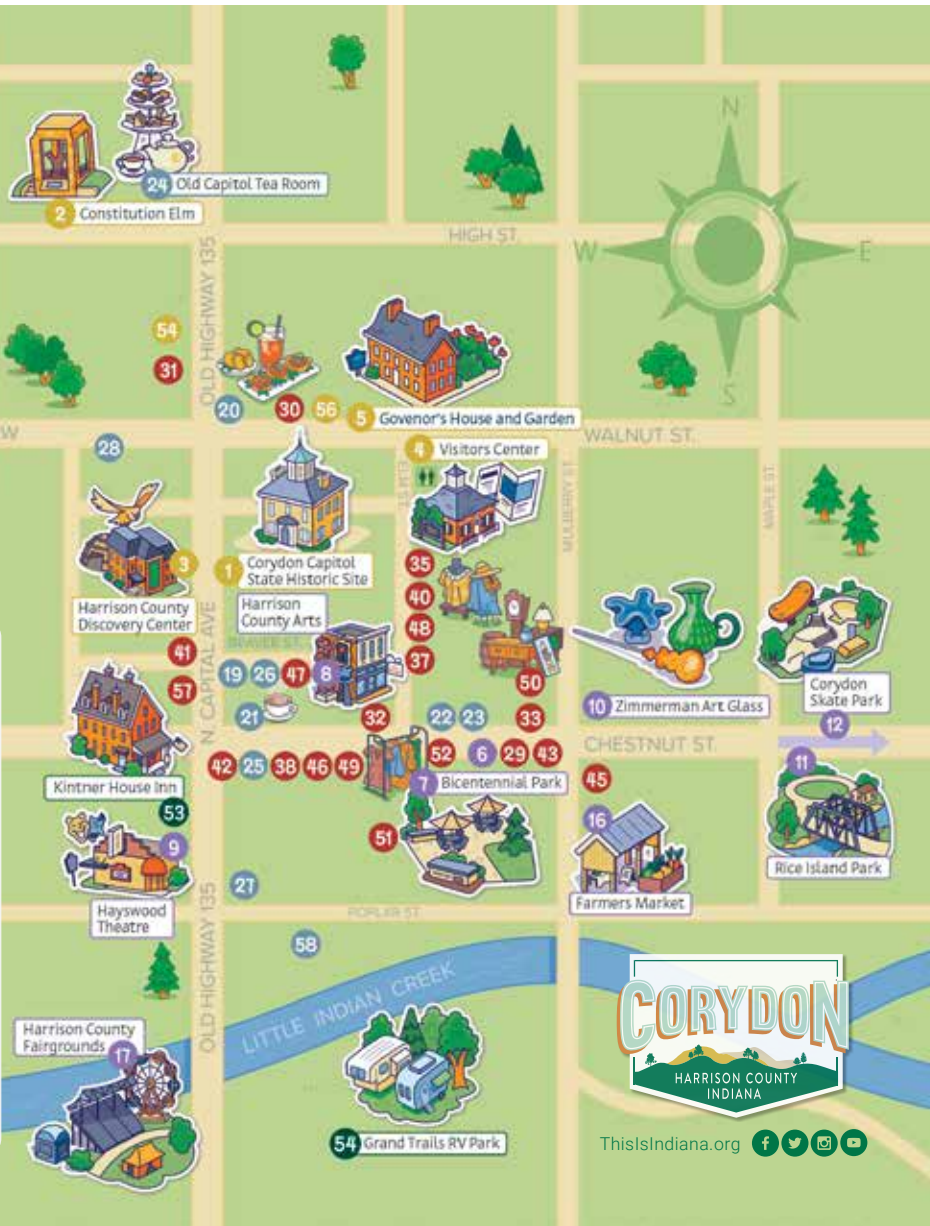
